## RESOLUTION 76-2019 **RESOLVED TO SUPPORT THE CAYUGA COUNTY WATER** AND SEWER AUTHORITY'S APPLICATION FOR A GRANT TO PREPARE A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY FOR SEWER SERVICES ON HONOCO ROAD

WHEREAS, the Cayuga County Water and Sewer Authority (CCWSA) was created as a corporate governmental agency constituting a public benefit corporation and its purpose is to serve the people of Cayuga County; and as part of the CCWSA's enabling legislation, a district to be known as the "Cayuga County Water and Sewer Authority District" was established, which embraces all of the territory located within Cayuga County; and

WHEREAS, the CCWSA's mission includes undertaking all necessary and reasonable actions within the district to conserve, preserve and protect the water supply to the district, including the making of plans and studies; and

WHEREAS, one element of that plan includes a project to provide sewer services to the lakeshore properties on Honoco Road; and

WHEREAS, the CCWSA has received numerous letters of support from Honoco residents for municipal water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS, a sewer system for Honoco Road would help alleviate potential issues with substandard septic systems affecting water quality in Cayuga Lake; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Honoco Road is within the Town of Genoa; and

WHEREAS, the CCWSA would develop, own and operate a Honoco Road sewer system under its authority as a regional water and wastewater agency; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Genoa would have no obligation to finance, own or operate a Honoco Road sewer system;

Now therefore be it resolved that, the Town of Genoa supports Cayuga County Water and Sewer Authority's grant application to complete a preliminary engineering report for a Honoco Road sewer system and that the Town of Genoa supports CCWSA in development and operation of the sewer system subject to CCWSA gaining necessary approvals and financing for the project.
